(a) & (b): Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL), a Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) under the administrative control of Department of Heavy Industry (DHI), Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises is having the status of Maharatna company owned by the Government.
