# Office Memorandum

## Subject: Constitution of an Inter Ministerial Committee(IMC) for the Capital Goods Sector

The undersigned is directed to inform that an Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC) for Capital Goods Sector has been constituted under the chairmanship of the Secretary, Department of Heavy Industry to coordinate efforts and actions required to be taken for the expedited development of a globally competitive Capital Goods Sector in India.

- The Committee shall have the representation from all the concerned Ministries/Departments
  of the Government of India consuming Capital Goods and heavy machinery to meet on a
  quarterly basis and deliberate to address the issues and bottlenecks pertaining to the sector.
- 3. The IMC shall suggest interventions and steps that can help in strengthening the Capital Goods sector in contributing more proactively in the national goal of achieving a USD 5 trillion economy and a USD 1 trillion manufacturing sector. This Committee can consider and deliberate on technology development, mother technology development, global value chains, testing, skill training, global standards, reciprocity issues, custom duties, etc. to make this sector globally competitive and to make India the manufacturing hub for the world. Any other relevant issues pertaining to the Capital Goods sector may also be brought before the Committee with the prior approval of the Chairman.
- 4. The IMC for the Capital Goods Sector is thus constituted as under, with representation from the other Ministries/ Departments at least at the Joint Secretary level:
