Monthly Summary of Significant Activities for the month of April, 2018

This has reference to your DO letter No. 502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated August 5, 2014 regarding important issues/developments. The following significant activities have taken place during the month of April, 2018 in the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI).

- 1. Secretary, DHI chaired the Apex Committee meeting held on 13.04.2018 to review the progress of various projects funded under the scheme on "Enhancement of competitiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector".
- Secretary, DHI led the DHI delegation from 23rd to 25th April, 2018 for participation in Hannover Messe, 2018 International Fair with focus on Industry 4.0. Indo-German round-table on Industry 4.0 was also organised. A visit was also made to Technical University of Darmstadt to understand the Industry – academia collaboration on Industry 4.0.
- 3. A round-table workshop was organised by CII with DHI's support on Industry 4.0 in New Delhi on 17.04.2018 to build awareness among the stakeholders.
- 4. The Phase–I of FAME- India Scheme has been extended further for a period of 6 months i.e. upto 30th September, 2018 or till the date of launching of Phase-II of FAME-India Scheme, whichever is earlier.
- 5. A draft EFC Note on FAME-II Policy was circulated among all stakeholders Ministries/ Departments of Government of India on 26.04.2018 for seeking their comments thereon by 11.05.2018. This is in line with the commitment made earlier before the COS for expeditiously bringing up the proposal for the second phase of the FAME scheme.
- 6. During the hearing held on 20.04.2018 in the matter of anti-suit injunction filed by Government of Tamil Nadu (GoTN) in the international arbitration proceedings initiated by Nissan Motors Ltd against Gol, the Hon'ble High Court of Madras allowed GoTN to file additional affidavit as per their request and the matter is now listed for 19th June, 2018. Informal meetings are understood to have been held between M/S NML and Govt of Tamil Nadu to thrash out the issues.
- An advertisement was released on 16th April, 2018 inviting Expression of Interest (EoI) from interested parties in connection with strategic disinvestment of Bharat Pumps & Compressors Ltd. (BPCL), Naini, Allahabad, a CPSE under DHI. The last date of submission of EoI is 28th May, 2018.
- A revised draft CCEA Note for Closure of Hooghly Printing Company Ltd, Kolkata, a subsidiary of Andrew Yule & Company Ltd, (AYCL) Kolkata has been circulated on 13th April, 2018 for inter-ministerial consultation based on comments received earlier.
- 9. Cabinet Note on closure of Nagaland Pulp and Paper Corporation was circulated on 18th April, 2018 for Inter-Ministerial consultation.
