Dear Sir,

With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated 5th August, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of May, 2022 are highlighted:

- 1. Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries, Dr. Mahendra Nath Pandey, chaired the meeting of 'हिंदी सलाहकार समिति' at Gangtok, Sikkim on 15th May 2022. The members of the committee reviewed the overall performance of use of Hindi in official work and appreciated the efforts made by the MHI including its CPSEs in promoting use of Hindi.
- 2. I along with senior officials of MHI, attended a briefing of 'Committee of Subordinate Legislation (Lok Sabha)' on 12th May, 2022 in Parliament House Annexe on the subject "Status of Rules and Regulations framed under the various Acts being administered by the Ministry and other CPSEs, Subsidiaries of CPSEs, Autonomous Bodies and Sector Skill Councils under the administrative control of MHI".
- 3. BHEL declared the audited financial results for the fourth quarter as well as consolidated results for FY 2021-22 duly approved by the Board of Directors on 21st May 2022. The Company is back in profit after two years of losses. The Board has recommended Final Dividend of 20% (Rs. 0.40 per share) on the paid-up share capital of the Company for FY 2021-22 after a span of 3 years.
- 4. 67 successful applicants have since submitted their Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) under the Component Champion scheme of PLI Auto, within the due date of 6th May 2022. Thus, 18 approved applicants under Champion OEM and 67 approved applicants under Component Champion incentive scheme are eligible for incentive in the PLI scheme for Automobiles and auto components.
- 5. Under FAME-II, grant amounting to Rs. 30.12 crores was released to City/ State Transport undertaking as under:
 - a. 2nd tranche of grant amounting to Rs. 19.62 crore was released for deployment of 109 Electric buses in the State of UP.
 - b. 2nd tranche of grant amounting to Rs. 7.20 crore was released for deployment of 40 Electric buses in the UT of Chandigarh.
 - c. 2nd tranche of grant amounting to Rs. 3.30 crore was released for deployment of 15 Electric buses in State of Goa.

- 6. MHI has signed an MoU with National Research Development Corporation (NRDC) on 18th May, 2022 for undertaking various activities for smooth implementation of the Scheme for Enhancement of Competitiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector. As per the MoU, NRDC will conduct activities like evaluation and review of the scheme, management of intellectual property rights and commercialization support for the technologies developed under Capital Goods Scheme (Phase-I & II) on behalf of MHI.
- 7. Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In May 2022, a total of 139 GST Concession Certificate have been issued.
- 8. National Automotive Test Tracks (NATRAX), Indore, a Testing Centre under MHI, has been approved for 'Crash Testing of Metal Beam Crash Barrier' by NHAI under MoRTH on 30th May 2022. Thus, testing of Metal Beam Crash Barrier will now be carried out in India as per safety requirements conforming to Indian road and traffic conditions.
