With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated August 5, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) for the month of December, 2018 are highlighted:

1. A meeting of Auto Cess Committee under my chairmanship was held on 20th December, 2018 for extending financial support to R&D and other projects to be funded out of the outlay under the head 'Development Council for Auto and Allied Industries' (DCAAI).
2. I participated in the meeting held on 20th December, 2018 at Cabinet Secretariat wherein a note on 'Total Mobility' prepared by NITI Aayog was considered by the Committee of Secretaries. DHI is working to finalise the cabinet note for the promotion of electric mobility.
3. NCLAT in its hearing on 03.12.2018 intending to hear on the appeal against NCLT order dated 13.06.2018 triggering Corporation Insolvency Resolution Process against Hindustan Paper Corporation (HPC) posted the matter for next hearing on 08.01.2019. NCLT has allowed the Resolution Professional of HPC to extend the Corporation Insolvency Resolution period by another 90 days w.e.f. 23.12.2018.
4. DHI made a presentation before 15th Finance Commission on electric mobility in public and shared transportation in megacities.
5. High level committee on the issue of transfer of Heavy Engineering Corporation (HEC) to Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) held its first meeting on 17th Dec 2018.
6. Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) has received 'Excellent' rating in respect of MoU 2017-18 for the second year in succession.
7. During the month, BHEL got the order booking of Rs. 6250 Crores, which includes Turnkey package of one 660 MW Sagardighi Thermal Power Project Extension Unit-5 from West Bengal Power Department Corporation Limited.
8. Five employees of BHEL have been declared winners for the prestigious Prime Minister's Shram Awards, 2017 announced by the Ministry of Labour & employment.

9. The 40th Nuclear Steam Generator (SG) has been dispatched from BHEL's Trichy manufacturing works on 1st December, 2018 for installation at Rajasthan Atomic Power Project (RAPP) of Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited . The clean room activities for this SG have been completed in record time of 3 and ½ months and post clean room activities completed in 3 months.
10. I attended the 8th meeting of the Over Arching Committee on Advanced Ultra Super Critical Project held at BHEL's Trichy unit chaired by the Principal Scientific Advisor to Govt. of India. The committee took note of the current status of the project and expressed confidence of the project's completion within the scheduled time.
11. Regeneration system of WAG-7 (5000 HP) electric locomotive developed by BHEL was successfully tested between Khajraha and Budhpur. This Development has been done for the first time in the country and shall result in regenerative energy saving of around 15%.
12. BHEL has manufactured its highest-rated motors for traction applications (110 kW), which was inaugurated by Member (Traction), Railway Board at its Bhopal manufacturing works, This motor is a major milestone which will culminate into manufacturing of indigenous 9000 HP locomotives at Chittaranjan Locomotive Works (CLW) of Indian Railways.
13. In view of the Cabinet Secretariat's direction dated 12-01-2017 vide D.O letter No.1/50/1/2017-Cab, the status of ACC directions/ orders as per the prescribed format are given as under:
