With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of February, 2022 are highlighted:

- 1. The Project Implementation and Sanctioning Committee (PISC) in its meeting held on 3.2.2022 recommended 20 applicants (along with their 12 subsidiaries) for the PLI Scheme for Automobile and Auto Companies for approval under "Champion OEM incentive Scheme". With the approval of Hon'ble Minister (HI), Letter of Approval has been issued to the applicants. The approved applicants have an investment commitment of Rs.45,016 crore.
- 2. Under FAME-II, grant amounting to Rs.75.86 crores was released to City / State Transport undertakings as under:
  - (i) 1st tranche of grant amounting to Rs.9 crore was released for deployment of 50 Electric Buses in the city of Tirupati and 50 Electric Buses for intercity operation in the State of AP.
- (ii) 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> tranche of grant amounting to Rs.14.30 crores was released for deployment of 35 Electric Buses in the State of Goa.
- (iii) 3<sup>rd</sup> tranche of grant amounting to Rs.34.92 crores was released for deployment of 194 Electric Buses in the State of Maharashtra.
- (iv) 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> tranche of grant amounting to Rs.17.64 crores was released for deployment of 49 Electric Buses in the city of Surat.
- 3. CEO, NITI Aayog and I jointly chaired a meeting on Ethanol Blending Programme smooth rollout & awareness campaign, on 22.2.2022 with all stakeholder Ministries / Departments and their agencies including SIAM. An indicative outline of the themes of the awareness campaign & roles and responsibilities of stakeholder Ministries / Departments have been deliberated and enumerated.
- 4. ICEMA-CECE Summit for Enhancing Collaboration and Trade relations in Construction Machinery between Europe and India was organized on 23.2.2022 via virtual mode. Indian Construction Equipment Manufacturers' Association (ICEMA) has been closely working with Committee for European Construction Equipment (CECE), an organization

which represents construction equipment manufacturers across 13 European countries. The summit focused on enhancing collaboration and trade relations in construction machinery industry between Europe and India.

- 5. The two Autonomous societies of MHI i.e. NATRIP Implementation Society (NATIS) & National Automotive Board (NAB) held its Governing Council (GC) and Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 9.2.2022 and inter alia among other items, approved amalgamation of NATIS and NAB under the provision of Section 12 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.
- 6. Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In February, 2022, 299 GST Concession Certificates have been issued. Further, as per mandate received from PMO and Cabinet Secretariat, onboarding of GST Concession Certificate Portal on UMANG app has been successfully completed on 28.2.2022 against the target date of 31.3.2022.
- 7 BHEL signed an MoU with Primetals Technologies India Pvt. Ltd. (PTIN) (a joint venture of Mitsubishi Heavy Industries & partners) for supply of Converter shells for converter vessels (upto 150 MT) used in Steel Melting Shops. This will enable BHEL to further diversify its offerings in Steel industry and help establish itself as an important supplier to the Steel sector, thus contributing to the cause of AatmaNirbhar Bharat Mission.
- Fabrication work shop of HPBP Trichy & HPVP Vizag, BHEL got approved for fabrication of cryogenic & non cryogenic pressure vessel under static & mobile pressure vessel (unfired) by 'Petroleum & Explosives Safety Organization' (PESO) with validity upto 31.12.2022 & 31.12.2023 respectively.
