Dear Sir,

With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated August 5, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) for the month of November, 2020 are highlighted:

1. As a step towards Digital India, an online portal for issuing GST concession certificates for purchase of vehicles by persons with "Orthopedic Physical Disability" has been developed and operationalised w.e.f. 12th November, 2020 where eligible applicants can submit their applications and receive GST concession certificates through online mode only.
2. A draft EFC memorandum on Productions Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme for the automobile and automobile components for enhancing India's capabilities in manufacturing and exports with a total outlay of Rs. 57,042 crores over a period of 5 years was prepared and circulated for stakeholders' comments on 19th November, 2020. The scheme also envisages increasing sourcing from India and will additionally incentivize R&D in India.
3. An Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC) has been formed for the Capital Goods with representation from all the concerned Ministries/ Departments dealing with the Capital Goods sector and using Capital Goods machinery. The IMC shall meet regularly to deliberate upon interventions to strengthen the sector and to address issues facing the sector. The first meeting of the IMC is proposed to be held on 16th December, 2020.
4. I had a meeting (virtual) with the Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI) on 26th November, 2020 to discuss issues relating to ethanol blending with petrol.
5. Letter of Awards were issued for 163 Charging stations (76 in the city of Indore, 37 in Lucknow, 20 in Jodhpur and 10 each in the cities of Kollam, Mallapuram, Thiruvananthapuram) as sanctioned under FAME India Scheme Phase-II.
6. BHEL has successfully manufactured and tested (short circuit) India's highest rating 500 MVA 400/220/33 kV Auto Transformer, at the National High Power Test Laboratory (NHPTL) at Bina in Madhya Pradesh - a new benchmark in the global transformer industry.

7. The maiden Indigenous Aircraft Carrier (IAC) –INS Vikrant successfully completed Basin trials at Kochi on 30 November 2020, wherein BHEL has supplied the Integrated Platform Management System (IPMS).
8. Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) signed between M/s. PRL (Progress Rail Ltd.) and BHEL on 24th November, 2020 for addressing various opportunities in transportation segment viz. Indian Railways 9000HP Loco, High speed electric passenger locomotive, Battery Operated or Dual Mode Locos etc.
9. CMD-BHEL, Director (Power), and other senior BHEL officials visited the Maitree site, Bangladesh, to review project status. High Commissioner of India in Bangladesh also joined the delegation at project site and subsequently, the project status and actions taken, were apprised to Principal Secretary to Prime Minister of Bangladesh.
10. BBJ has paid a dividend to the Government of India amounting to Rs.10.32 crores for the financial year 2019-20.
11. The Department observed the Samvidhan Diwas on 26th November, 2020 and I administered the Pledge to the Department Officials.
12. The Department observed the Communal Harmony Campaign Week during November 19-25, 2020 and the Flag Day on 25th November, 2020.
13. In view of the Cabinet Secretariat's direction dated 12-01-2017 vide D.O letter No.1/50/1/2017-Cab, the status of ACC directions/ orders as per the prescribed format are given as under:
