With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated 5th August, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of April 2022 are highlighted:

- Dr. Mahendra Nath Pandey, Hon'ble Minister of Heavy Industries chaired the Consultative Committee meeting of MHI on the theme 'Climate Change and Manufacturing' at Srinagar, Jammu & Kashmir on 15th April 2022. BHEL and NITI Aayog made the presentation before the Consultative Committee.
- 2. A meet on 'Corporate Governance' was organized by MHI on 7th April, 2022 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi wherein all Functional and Independent Directors of CPSEs under MHI participated and learnt best practices as a part of peer learning. Independent Directors gave constructive suggestions to improve performance of their respective CPSEs. They also intimated their contributions for successful operations and effective management.
- 3. I chaired meeting of Inter-Ministerial Apex Committee for the Capital Goods Scheme on 8th April, 2022 to review the ongoing projects of the Phase 1 of the Scheme for Enhancement of the Competitiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector and to consider the new project proposals recommended by the Screening Committee under the Phase 2 of the Capital Goods Scheme. 06 proposals have been approved in principle valuing Rs.224.30 crore with MHI grant of Rs. 192.20 crore.
- 4. 19 successful applicants under the OEM category for PLI Auto have since submitted their Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) with in the due date of 8th April 2022.
- 5. Under FAME-II, grant amounting to Rs.18.024 crores was released to City / State Transport undertakings as under:
 - a) 1st tranche of grant amounting to Rs.16.5 crore was released for deployment of 150 electric buses for intercity operation; 100 by Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC) and 50 by North Western Karnataka Road Transport Corporation.
 - b) Part payment of 2nd tranche of grant amounting to Rs.1.524 crores was released for deployment of 16 Electric buses in DMRC, Delhi.
- 6. Issue of GST concession certificate is one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In April, 2022, 99 GST concession certificates have been issued.

During the recent visit of UK Prime Minister, Mr. Boris Johnson, BHEL signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with GE Power Conversion in the presence of UK's Minister for Defence Procurement, Mr. Jeremy Quin and the British High Commissioner, H.E. Alex Ellis, on 25th April 2022 for the development of 'Integrated Electric Propulsion Systems' for Indian Navy. With the signing of the MoU, the expertise and facilities of GE Power Conversion and BHEL can be leveraged for quick induction of this advanced technology by the Indian Navy.
- BHEL commissioned '22 MW Floating Solar Power Project' at NTPC Kayamkulam on 20th April 2022 on backwater from the Sea.
