OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Procedure and Guidelines for the engagement of Technical/Professional Consultants in the M/o Heavy Industries-reg

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's OM of even number dated 21.10.2021 vide which the procedure and guidelines for the engagement of Technical/ Professional consultant were issued. To ensure uniformity in the process of engagement or extension, the following clarifications are issued:

- i) The concerned Division will obtain the concurrence of Financial Adviser and approval of Secretary (HI) for engaging the requisite number of Technical / Professional Consultants / Consultants (Retd. Govt. Servant) from the necessity and financial angle clearly bringing out initial tenure of engagement and provision for subsequent extensions based on requirement and suitability.
- ii) After obtaining of such approval of SHI for engaging a specific number of Consultants, all other matters such as publishing of advertisement for applications, constitution of selection panel, appointment of selected candidates and their subsequent extensions, increase of remuneration (up to 5% of the remuneration) etc. shall be done with the approval of the concerned Additional Secretary / Joint Secretary / Economic Adviser of the Division concerned.
- iii) In the advertisement and in the appointment letter, the tenure of the consultant should be clearly indicated. In case the initial engagement of consultants is primarily set for a period of one year then it should also mention extensibility of tenure up to four more years on annual basis subject to satisfactory performance and requirement of the concerned Division. Appointment of consultant should not be more than five years in any case.
- iv) Before appointing or giving extension to any consultant, the availability of fund in the concerned budget head should be ensured.
- 2. All the concerned division are requested to engage consultants or extend their tenure accordingly.
- 3. This issues with the approval of the Secretary (HI) and concurrence of IF Wing.
