To safeguard Human Safety of Electric Vehicles, the following compliance will be made mandatory with effect from 1st October 2023, for claiming incentives/ payouts under the **PLI Scheme for Automobile and Auto Components and FAME II scheme**, being implemented by MHI :-

“EV safety and battery safety compliance requirements have already been made stringent vide amendment 3 to AIS 156 and AIS 038 Rev2 standards notified under CMVR by Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH). Therefore, the above compliance is adequate and to be followed.”
