

The performance highlights of the Department of Heavy Industry for the month of August, 2013:-

I Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd. (BHEL)

(a) Order Booking:

The total order receipts in the current financial year up-to August 2013 has reached a level of **Rs.2725 Crs.** which include orders worth **Rs. 340 Crs.** booked during August 2013.

Major orders received during the month include:

(i) Power Sector:

- ❖ Order worth **Rs 86.64 Crs** for
 - Capital Maintenance along with repair of Underwater parts for Dehar Hydro Power Plant from Bhakra Beas Management Board (BBMB).

(ii) Industry Sector:

- ❖ Order worth **Rs 228 Crs** for
 - Development of 15 MW Solar PV plant in Madhya Pradesh from NTPC.
 - Extension of 400 kV substations in Durgapur, Maithon, Biharsharif & Purnea from Power Grid.
 - 39 nos. 500 kVA Generator Transformers from CLW, Chittaranjan

(iii) International Operations:

- ❖ Orders worth **Rs. 25.53 Crs** for
 - Long Term Service Agreement (LTSA) for 6 years for Generator & Balance Of Plant (BOP) equipment of 2 x 120 MW Siddhirganj Power Plant, Bangladesh.
 - Spares and Services from Indonesia, Iraq, Kuwait, Oman & UAE.

(b) R&D:

BHEL spent around **Rs.72 Crores** on R&D initiatives during August'13 and filed 37 **Patents/ Copyrights.**

II NTPC-BHEL Power Projects Private Limited (NBPPPL):

The cumulative turnover of NBPPPL is Rs. 38.13 Crore up to August, 2013 in the current financial year.

III. Automotive Sector:

(a) 1st meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Group (IMG) on Electric Vehicles was held on August 16, 2013 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Heavy Industry in order to navigate the pilot scheme for launch of electric vehicles in Delhi, and subsequently in other places.

(b) Meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Group (IMG) on Auto Recall and End of Life was held on 19/08/2013 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Heavy Industry.

(c) 67th meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Group (IMG) on Taxation, Fiscal & Investment Policy held on 21/08/2013 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Heavy Industry.

(d) A meeting was held on 26/08/2013 under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, Shri Ambuj Sharma, Heavy Industry to discuss the implementation of pilot project for public transport with electric/hybrid vehicle in Delhi.

IV Performance of major PSEs

A brief tabular statement on the performance of some of the major CPSEs under the Department of Heavy Industry is enclosed at Annex-I. The production of these companies upto **July, 2013** was -22.13 % lower as compared to the corresponding period last year.
