• Cabinet in its meeting held on 31.3.2011 has approved this Department's proposal for setting up of National Council for Electric Mobility (NCEM) and National Board for Electric Mobility (NBEM) for mission mode approach to expand electric mobility and manufacture of electric vehicles (including hybrids) and their components in India. As a follow up to this decision, the Department has set up the NCEM and NCBM on 27<sup>th</sup> May 2011 and Gazette Notification has been issued to GoI press for publication.
