With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated 5th August, 2014

of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of January, 2023 are highlighted:

- 1. In the august presence of Dr. Mahendra Nath Pandey, Hon'ble Minister for Heavy Industries, on 19th January 2023 in Pune, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been signed by Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI) with Advance Mobility Transformation & Innovation Foundation (AMTIF) for facilitating startup and innovation ecosystem of Automobile. AMTIF is setting up Accelerator on Automobile related technologies sanctioned by MHI under the Phase-II of the Scheme for Enhancement of Competitiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector. During the event, AMTIF exchanged MoU with ten Industry Partners and startups selected under umbrella of Industrial Accelerator.
- 2. I chaired the meeting of the Inter-Ministerial Apex Committee for the Capital Goods Scheme on 24th January 2023 to consider the 11 new project proposals recommended by the Screening Committee under the Phase-II of the Scheme for Enhancement of Competitiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector. I also reviewed the progress of the projects of Phase-I of the Scheme in the meeting. Out of total outlay of Rs. 1207 Crore, MHI has till date sanctioned projects of Rs.910 Crore having Government contribution of Rs. 722.50 Crore and Industry contribution of Rs.187.5 crore.
- 3. I had two meetings with NITI Aayog and Project Management Agency (PMA) i.e. Industrial Finance Corporation of India (IFCI) on Production Linked Incentive - Advance Chemistry Cell (PLI-ACC) Scheme to review the progress.

## 4. FAME - II:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> tranche of grant amounting to Rs.66 crores was released to Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC).
- Demand Incentive of Rs.89.50 crore was released to M/s. Ola Electric ii. Technologies Pvt. Ltd.
- 5. Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In January 2023, a total of 353 GST Concession Certificates have been issued.
