MONTHLY SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES FOR JANUARY, 2016

A. Automotive Sector:

- i. **Return of additional land of Auto Testing Track of NATRiP to the Government of Madhya Pradesh:** The proposal for returning of additional land of Auto Testing Track of NATRiP Project in Pithampur, Indore (NATRAX), Madhya Pradesh was considered by the Union Cabinet in its meeting held on 27th January, 2016. Cabinet approved the proposal of returning of approx. 478.307 Hectares of land, comprising approx. 461.607 Hectares private acquired land and 16.70 Hectares Government land free of cost to the Government of Madhya Pradesh.
- ii. **Meeting of Project Implementation and Sanctioning Committee (PISC) on FAME-India:** The 4th Meeting of Project Implementation and Sanctioning Committee (PISC) for the FAME initiative was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (DHI) on 22nd January, 2016 at Udyog Bhawan, New Delhi to review the progress made on decisions taken in the last three meetings and to consider given new proposals. In principal approvals were accorded to three new proposals by the Committee, i.e. (i) Proposal for xEVI, (ii) Proposal of H.P. City Transport & Bus Stands Management & Development Authority, Shimla (HP) and (iii) Guidelines for procurement of Electric Bus under Pilot Project of FAME – India Scheme.
- iii. **Inauguration of new ARAI facilities at Chakan:** The Newly created facilities at Chakan under ARAI under NATRiP project was inaugurated by Shri Anant G. Geete, Hon'ble Minister (HI&PE) on 4th January, 2016.
- iv. **Meeting of Development Council for Automotive and Allied Industries (DCAAI):** A meeting of the Development Council for Automotive and Allied Industries (DCAAI) was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (DHI) on 27th January, 2016 at Udyog Bhawan, New Delhi, wherein the Automotive Mission Plan 2016-26 was considered and approved by the Council.

B. Heavy Engineering & Machine Tools Sector:

- i. **Meeting of Apex Committee for "Enhancing the Competitiveness of Capital Goods Sector":** The Apex Committee for "Enhancing the Competitiveness of

Capital Goods Sector" in its 3rd Meeting held on 28th January, 2016 considered and approved the following four critical projects for the development of the country:

- a) A joint venture between Government of India and Government of Karnataka for a first of its kind Integrated Machine Tools Park at Tumkur. When implemented fully, the park is expected to help in doubling the combined turnover of Indian machine tool industry to Rs. 9000 crore and creation of more than one lakh jobs.
 - b) A Welding Technology Centre of Excellence in PSG College of Technology, Coimbatore, in collaboration with Welding Research Institute, Manufacturers of welding equipment/products and FICCI etc. The Centre of Excellence will support Indian manufacturers by providing latest technologies developed by the Centre for home-made welding machine tools, consumables and locally trained manpower particularly in high-end welding jobs required by strategic sectors.
 - c) Collaboration by HMT Machine Tools Ltd. with M/s. Fraunhofer of Germany, the leading industrial technology development institute of the world, for modernizing its lathe and turning mill centre to supply the most modern and latest range of machines to Railways, Defence, Shipping, Aviation and Aerospace etc.
 - d) Collaboration by Heavy Engineering Corporation (HEC), Ranchi, with M/s. CNIITMASH – a Russian government Industrial Technology Research Institute for setting up a Centre of Excellence in Heavy Engineering Design to train 1350 engineers in three years in the latest technologies relating to electro slag re-melting, welding, gear box manufacturing and non-destructive testing..
- ii. **MOU between DHI and IIT:** An MOU was signed between DHI and IIT, Chennai for development of Center of Excellence for Machine Tool Technologies at IIT Chennai. The Center envisages to help the machine tool industry by providing necessary inputs for technology upgradation.

C. Heavy Engineering Industries/CPSES under DHI:

- i. **Closure of HMT Watches, HMT Chinar Watches and HMT Bearings Ltd.:** Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs which was held on 6th January, 2016 approved closure of the loss making CPSEs namely HMT Watches Ltd., HMT Chinar Watches Ltd. and HMT Bearing Ltd. by offering them attractive VRS/VSS package to their employees and disposal of their movable and immovable assets as per the Government policy.
- ii. **BHEL bagged order for setting up a Thermal Power Station in Tamil Nadu:** BHEL bagged an order for setting up a Thermal Power Station - Stage III of 1 x 800 MW in North Chennai from Tamil Nadu Generation & Distribution Corporation. Significantly, this will be the first ever 800 MW supercritical set in the state of Tamil Nadu. Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu handed over the Letter of Award to CMD-BHEL, during the function held in Chennai on 29th January, 2016.
- iii. **Protocol signed between Government of Czech Republic and Department of Heavy Industry:** The Union Cabinet in its meeting dated 6th January, 2016 took note of the Protocol signed between Ministry of Industry & Trade, Government of Czech Republic and Department of Heavy Industry, Government of India on 24th November, 2015 to promote bilateral cooperation in the field of heavy industry. The Protocol includes the intent for modernization of the existing facilities in India by the Czech companies, including modernization of three plants of Heavy Engineering Corporation, CPSE under DHI at Ranchi, set up inter alia with Czech support in the early 1960's.

D. Others Miscellaneous Activities

- i. **Secretary DHI participated in the deliberations of the Group of Secretaries:** Secretary DHI has participated in the deliberations of the Group of Secretaries on "Innovative Budgeting and Effective Implementation". A presentation was made by the Group before the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 21st January, 2016.
