With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated August 5, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) for the month of January, 2019 are highlighted:

1. A meeting on 'Total mobility' was chaired by Principal Secretary to Prime Minister on 09th January, 2019 in which proposal of FAME-II for boosting adoption of electric vehicles in the country was discussed.
2. The 11th Meeting of Project Implementation and Sanctioning Committee (PISC) was held under my chairmanship on 3rd January 2019 wherein proposals for sanctioning grant under Fame-India Scheme for creation of EV testing infrastructure at Manesar and Chennai and charging infrastructure along Delhi-Jaipur-Agra, Delhi-Chandigarh and Mumbai -Pune Highways approved.
3. "SIAT-2019", an International Conference on Automobile technology was held at ARAI, Pune from 16th -18th January, 2019. It witnessed the participation from across the world.
4. Draft cabinet note on 'FAME India Phass-II' scheme based on EFC appraisal and as cleared by CoS was sent for approval of the Finance Minister on 15th January, 2019.
5. In the context of the proposal for revival of Hindustan Paper Corporation (HPC) and ongoing Corporate Insolvency Resolution Proceedings (CIRP), the NCLAT has dismissed the Appeal filed by CMD, HPC. At the same time, based on the application by the Resolution Professional (RP) with the approval of creditors the NCLT Delhi has granted extension of CIRP for further period of 90 days.
6. Expression of Interest inviting bids for disinvestment of Bridge and Roofs Co Ltd was closed on 25th January 2019 with sufficient bidder response.
7. DHI has drawn up a Calendar of 25 awareness seminars on Industry 4.0. for creating awareness amongst India's manufacturing sector about the benefits of adopting Industry 4.0 techniques to achieve global competitiveness. These events will be organized with various stakeholders such as CII, FICCI, EEPCC, CMTI, IITs and IISc.
8. I co-chaired with Secretary (Power) a meeting of High Level Monitoring Committee on 17-01-2019 for implementation monitoring of Maitree Super Thermal Power Project of 1320 MW at Rampal, Bagerghat, Bangladesh.

9. A review meeting was held by me under the co-chairmanship of Secretary Power to discuss Phase II of the Advanced Ultra Supercritical Technology (AUSC) for Thermal Power Plants. During the meeting NTPC and BHEL agreed to set up a Joint Venture for carrying forward the AUSC agenda.
10. During the financial year 2018-19, up to January 2019, BHEL achieved a provisional turnover of about Rs. 21000 Crore while total order booking till Jan 2019 is of the order of Rs. 18700 Crore, that includes Rs. 1440 Crore order received during the month.
11. BHEL is setting up a network of solar based electric vehicle chargers (SEVC) on the 250 kms Delhi-Chandigarh highway under the FAME scheme of DHI. Initially 20 Charging stations, 10 on each side will be established at identified resorts/petrol pumps/eateries. First station will be launched in the month of Feb. 2019.
12. A Memorandum of Understanding was signed for 2017 wage revision of BHEL workmen at the BHEL's apex level bipartite forum.
13. The 7th meeting of the Project Review and Monitoring committee for the Advanced Ultra Supercritical (AUSC) project along with other meetings for the project were held on 30-31 January, 2019 at Dadri units of NTPC Ltd.
14. Awards/recognitions for BHEL: (i) CBIP Award 2019 for 'Best Power Equipment Manufacturing Organisation' was presented by Shri R.K. Singh, Hon'ble Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for New & Renewable Energy and Power, (ii) Governance Now PSU Awards 2019 for 'Best PSE in Strategic Performance' and 'Best PSE in Digitalisation', (iii) 'Excellence in manufacturing of Rolling Stock components and New Innovations' award at Rail Analysis India Summit 2019, (iv) Power Sector of BHEL was 'Recognised for Active Customer Engagement' – of the 'CII Award for Customer Obsession-2018.
15. In view of the Cabinet Secretariat's direction dated 12-01-2017 vide D.O letter No.1/50/1/2017-Cab, the status of ACC directions/ orders as per the prescribed format are given as under:
