Dear Sir,

With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated August 5, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) for July, 2019 are highlighted:

- 1. His Excellency the Governor of Jammu and Kashmir and the Hon'ble Minister for Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises flagged off 20 Electric Buses at Srinagar on 19thJuly 2019. These buses were sanctioned to Jammu and Kashmir under Phase I of FAME India scheme.
- 2. The 2nd meeting of the Project Implementation and Sanctioning Committee (PISC) was held under my chairmanship on 29th July 2019. PISC reviewed the progress of FAME India Scheme phase II and also recommended sanction of 5595 electric buses to 64 Cities/STUs, in response to the Expression of Interest issued on 4thJune 2019 by the Department for deployment of electric buses. Sanction of 5000 electric buses is one of the impactful decisions to be implemented in the first 100 days of the new Government.
- 3. An Expression of Interest (EoI), inviting proposals for development of charging infrastructure under FAME India Scheme Phase-II, was issued on 12th July 2019. Through this, the Department aims to support establishment of about 1000 charging stations in major cities of the country.
- 4. An awareness workshop on Smart Manufacturing and Industry 4.0 "Preparing for Digital Transformation in Indian Manufacturing" was organized by DHI in Hyderabad on 12th July 2019. The workshop was attended by industry participants and experts. During the workshop, the German and Japanese perspectives on Internet of Things (IoT)/ Industry 4.0 were also presented.
- 5. Intelligence Bureau (MHA) vide their letter dated 03.07.2019 confirmed approval for the purchase of 1.04 acres of Instrumentation Limited, Kota land at Malviya Nagar, Jaipur at a cost of Rs.21.80 Crore.
- 6. The National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) has, through an order dated 2.5.2019, directed the liquidation of Hindustan Paper Corporation (HPC). On 29.5.2019, the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT) revised this NCLT order by directing the Liquidator to liquidate HPC as 'a going concern'. Accordingly, the Liquidator submitted a request to the Department seeking funds till a scheme of arrangement under Section 230 of the Companies Act 2013 is approved by the Adjudicating Authority, or the Corporate Debtor is sold as a going concern to a third party. An agenda note was sent to Cabinet Secretariat on 22.07.2019 for consideration of the Committee of Secretaries (COS).

- 7. Joint Secretary (Auto) interacted with all registered OEMs under Phase-II of FAME Scheme at Udyog Bhawan on 25th July 2019 to streamline uploading of data related to sale on the web portal developed for FAME Phase-2.
- 8. BHEL and Container Corporation of India Limited (CONCOR) signed an agreement on 8th July 2019 to form a Joint Working Group (JWG) named BHELCON, for setting up a Railbased Logistics Terminal at Haridwar. This is in consonance with BHEL's endeavour to diversify its business.
- 9. BHEL entered into a MoU with SJVN Ltd. on 9th July 2019 for collaboration in development of Solar PV projects.
- 10. BHEL and NTPC Ltd. signed an MoU on 24th July 2019 to establish a Joint Venture Company, which will set up an Advanced Ultra Supercritical (AUSC) Technology Demonstration Plant of 800 MW at Sipat.
- 11. BHEL supplied 4 special tanks and rings on board ISRO's Chandrayaan-2 modules. This is a very significant contribution by the Company in the Space Programme of the country.
- 12. EEPC India Northern Region Award for 'Engineering Export Excellence Top Exporter for the year 2016-17- Large Enterprise: Silver Trophy' given to BHEL on 20th July 2019.
- 13. In view of the Cabinet Secretariat's direction dated 12-01-2017 vide D.O letter No.1/50/1/2017-Cab, the status of ACC directions/ orders, as per the prescribed format, is given as under:
