



MONTHLY SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITIES FOR JUNE, 2016

- 1. MoU on co-operation in manufacturing between DHI and Steinbeis:** MoU on co-operation in the field of manufacturing between the Department of Heavy Industry and Steinbeis GmbH Co. KG for Technology transfer, Germany was placed in the Cabinet Meeting on 22.06.2016 for information.
- 2. Budgetary support for Technology Development:** Budgetary support amounting to Rs.10.31 crore (Rupees Ten crore and Thirty One Lakh only), towards the first installment of non-recurring Grant-in-Aid (General) (Plan), has been released to PSG College of Technology, Coimbatore, Tamilnadu, for developing two projects namely, (i) Automated Welding Systems for Specific Industrial Applications and (ii) Alloy Design for Welding Simulation & Analysis for Development of New Welding Electrodes & Filler Metals, under the Scheme for Enhancement of Global Competitiveness of Indian Capital Goods Sector during the month of June, 2016.
- 3. Framing of CEMM Bill:** Secretaries, HI has a brief presentation by PLR Chambers regarding framing of Construction, Earthmoving, Material Handling and Mining Machinery (CEMM) Bill on 30-06-2016. This legislation would be applicable to off-road equipment, which are not covered under the CMVR (Central Motor Vehicles Rules 1989). The draft CEMM Equipment Bill would be put up on DHI's Website for seeking views from users, importers, etc. After this, regional consultations would be held with users, manufacturers, dealers etc. M/s. PLR Chambers and Indian Construction Equipment Manufacturers Association (ICEMA) were asked to justify this legislation with supporting data regarding accident, emissions etc. and I advised that the entire drafting of the legislation be conducted in a time bound manner.
- 4. BHEL commissioned two units of Salma Hydro Electric Project in Afghanistan:** BHEL commissioned two units of 3×14 MW Salma Hydro Electric Project in Afghanistan which was jointly inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India and Hon'ble President of Afghanistan.
- 5. Commencement of work for Yelahanka Combined Cycle Power Plant (CCPP) by Chief Minister of Karnataka:** Hon'ble Chief Minister of Karnataka, Shri Siddaramaiah inaugurated the commencement of work for the 370MW Yelahanka combined Cycle Power Plant (CCPP), to be executed by BHEL.
- 6. Afghanistan- India Friendship Dam:** In recognition of BHEL's contribution towards setting up of the 'Salma Hydro Electric Project (renamed as Afghan-India Friendship Dam)' in Afghanistan. BHEL was honoured with an appreciation shield by the Hon'ble Union Minister of External Affairs, Smt. Sushma Swaraj and Hon'ble Union Minister of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga rejuvenation, Ms. Uma Bharti. BHEL successfully overcame all the challenges/ obstacles in the execution of the project and synchronized both the units well within targets set out by Ministry of External Affairs.

7. **Welding Research Institute (WRI) and Heavy Electrical Equipments Plant (HEEP), of BHEL conferred with 'Scotch BSE Award, 2016':** Welding Research Institute (WRI), Trichy and Heavy Electrical Equipments Plant (HEEP), Haridwar of BHEL were conferred with 'Scotch BSE Award, 2016' for innovative Technology Deployment Initiatives and Nurturing creativities respectively.
8. **World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulation** Joint Secretary (Auto), DHI participated in the 169th Session of WP-29, a World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulation, at Geneva from 21st to 24th June, 2016.
9. **Visited to Volvo Plant at Sweden:** Joint Secretary (Auto), DHI visited Volvo Plant at Gothenburg, Sweden during 18th to 21st June, 2016 in connection with National mission on Electric Mobility (NMEM), in general, and FAME India Scheme of the Government, in particular.
