With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated August 5, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) for the month of June, 2019 are highlighted:

- 1. The Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises, Shri Arvind G. Sawant and the Hon'ble Minister of State for Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises and Parliamentary Affairs, Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal reviewed the performance and future readiness of BHEL during their visits to BHEL's corporate office at Delhi.
- 2. The Hon'ble Minister of State for HI&PE and Parliamentary Affairs reviewed the operations of BHEL power sector, Southern region, at Chennai on 14th June 2019.
- 3. As part of the Industry 4.0 awareness campaign, the Department organized two awareness seminars during June 2019. One event was held at Coimbatore with CMTI & CII on 21st June 2019. The other seminar was held in Bengaluru with IISc on 28-29 June 2019. Both the events were well attended by representatives of Industry, and helped the industry and other stakeholders to understand the ways in which smart manufacturing can be adopted.
- 4. During the month, Secretary Heavy Industry chaired the following meetings concerning the Automobile sector:
 - 1st meeting, on 17.6.19, of the Inter Ministerial Group (IMG) constituted for smooth migration of the auto industry to BS VI compliant emission norms w.e.f 1st April 2020. IMG expressed its satisfaction that Industry is fully geared up for migrating to BS VI. However, the Industry Association sought early availability of BS VI compliant fuel well before the date of migration i.e. 1st April 2020 for smooth migration to BS VI emission norms.
 - Inter-ministerial consultation was held on 17th June 2019 to encourage the adoption of electric mobility by Government departments like M/o Civil Aviation, M/o Tourism, M/o Culture, M/O EF&CC etc. They were persuaded to adopt Electric vehicles instead of regular vehicles. Department of Heavy Industry assured to extend necessary support for any such initiative to replace diesel/petrol vehicles with electric vehicles under FAME India Scheme Phase II.
 - 68th Meeting of the Governing Council of NATRIP Implementation Society (NATIS) was held on 27th June 2019.
- 5. An Expression of Interest, inviting proposals for deployment of 5000 Electric Buses under FAME India Scheme Phase II, was issued on 4th June 2019.
- 6. A series of meetings were held between DHI and Ministry of Power to finalize EOI for inviting proposals to establish charging stations.

- 7. The CCEA, in its meeting on 13.02.2019, had approved the proposal of strategic disinvestment of EPIL to an incorporated entity or a company (including CPSEs). After initiating the process, the advertisement seeking Expression of Interest from interested bidders was issued on 29.6.2019.
- 8. As approved by the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA), the units of Cement Corporation of India Limited (CCI), where legally permissible, are to be disinvested, unit wise or in group of units, to a strategic buyer identified through a two-stage auction process The disinvestment of the non-operational CCI unit at Nayagaon

 MP is underway. This process shall now be carried out under DIPAM; accordingly, a the Evaluation Committee has been reconstituted under the Chairpersonship of AS&FA, DIPAM. Two meetings of the reconstituted Evaluation committee have since been held during June 2019.
- 9. BHEL observed Environmental Awareness Month (June 2019) in the backdrop of World Environment Day (5 June 2019), during which various events/ competitions/ expert talks were organized within the company.
- 10. Awards / recognition of BHEL:
 - I. SKOCH order of Merit Awards for the project "360 Degree Solarisation Across Value Chain" under the category of Environment Management on 29th June 2019.
 - II. SKOCH order of Merit Awards for the project "Solar Passive Tracker for SPV Array" under the category of Technology Deployment on 29th June 2019.
- 11. An inter-organizational meet on the theme, "Learning Leads to Transformation", among select CPSUs, was organized by BHEL on 17th June 2019, in which various CPSEs (viz. BEL, CIL, EIL, IOCL, NTPC, NHPC, PGCIL, SAIL, BHEL) participated.
- 12. Two executives of BBJ attended a workshop on "Internal Financial Control under Companies Act" on 28th June, 2019, organized by Department of Public Enterprises, in association with India Institute of Corporate Affairs.
- 13. In view of the Cabinet Secretariat's direction dated 12-01-2017 vide D.O letter No.1/50/1/2017-Cab, the status of ACC directions/ orders as per the prescribed format are given as under:
