Skill Training to Youth by PSUs

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether under the 'Skill India' initiative, the Ministry has asked all the Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) under its administrative control to prepare modules and provide training to youth in their respective sectors and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of PSUs that have started their training centres for both conventional training on machinery and high end training on computer;
- (c) the target fixed by the PSUs for skilling the youth annually along with the funds allocated for the purpose; and
- (d) the other steps taken/being taken by the Government to achieve the target of skilling 24 lakh youth in a year fixed by the Government?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI G.M. SIDDESHWARA)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. All the Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) under the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) have been instructed to provide training to youth in their respective sectors. PSUs, like Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd., Rajasthan Electricals & Instruments Ltd., Instrumentation Ltd., Andrew Yule & Company Ltd., Bharat Pumps & Compressors Ltd., Hooghly Printing Company Ltd., Cement Corporation of India Ltd. are providing training on various subjects such as Advance Management Programme, General Management Programme, Strategic Management Programme, Young Managers Programmes, operation of Electronic Equipments, Test Repair at Instrument level, Test and Repair of Printed Circuit Board, Cables, Power Supply, Mobile Repairing & Servicing, Refrigeration and JAVA, C++, Dot Net, Visual Basic, MS SQL, Oracle, MS Office etc. in the Information Technology Sector.
- (c) & (d): PSUs under DHI have been given the target to skill 40,000 persons in the year 2015-16 by National Skill Development Council. However, separate funds have not been allocated to the PSUs from this Department for this purpose. The performance of PSUs towards skill development is monitored on monthly and quarterly basis to improve the performance.
