- (a) the salient features of Heavy Industry Export and Market Development Assistance (HIEMDA) Scheme along with the present status thereof;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated, sanctioned and utilised under the said scheme during the last three years, State-wise including Gujarat;
- (c) the number of persons benefited under the scheme during the said period;
- (d) the targets set and achievement under the said scheme so far along with the steps taken to achieve the target, State/ UT-wise; and
- (e) whether the Government has received any complaint regarding misuse of the funds, if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard?
