Modernisation of Cachar Paper Mill

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there are any liabilities of Hindustan Paper Corporation in Nagaon and Cachar Paper Mill in Assam;
(b) if so, the details thereof; and
(c) whether the Government is taking any steps to modernize the Cachar Paper Mill and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI G.M. SIDDESHWARA)

(a): Yes.

(b): As on 30.11.2015, liability of Hindustan Paper Corporation (HPC) in Cachar Paper Mill (CPM) and Nagaon Paper Mill (NPM) is Rs. 401.22 crore and Rs. 415.81 crore respectively. Details are given below:
