Dear Sir,

With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated August 5, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of August, 2021 are highlighted:

1. Hon'ble Minister of Heavy Industries inaugurated the solar based Electric Vehicle charging station at Karna Lake Resort on 18/08/2021. This charging station is strategically located at the midpoint of Delhi-Chandigarh Highway and is capable of charging all types of electric Two Wheelers (e-2 W), Three Wheelers (e-3 W) and Four Wheelers (e-4 W). The charging station was installed by Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL). "Delhi-Chandigarh highway has become the first electric vehicle highway in the country."
2. Under phase-II of FAME India Scheme the first tranche of instalment of grant amounting to Rs. 4.5 crores was released to Gujarat State Road Transport Corporation (GSRTC) for deployment of 50 Electric Buses sanctioned.
3. I addressed a Session on "India as a Manufacturing Powerhouse" at the CII Annual Meeting on 11th August, 2021 through virtual platform wherein it was highlighted that India is on the path to become global epicentre for high tech manufacturing. The initiatives taken by the Ministry for strengthening industry-academia ties for engendering technology development for products with high end technology were also shared during the session.
4. The performance of CPSEs under the Ministry was reviewed on 26th August, 2021. The review focussed on financial and operational performance and initiatives for efficiency improvement, profitability enhancement and modernization of CPSEs.
5. The Swachhta Pakhwada 2021 was observed successfully by the Ministry and its Central Public-Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) & Autonomous Bodies from 16th August, 2021 to 31st August, 2021.
6. 18 employees from BHEL have been declared winners for 11 prestigious Prime Minister's Shram Awards (PMSA) for 2018 declared by Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India. This is the highest ever achievement by BHEL's workmen from the date of incorporation (1985) of PMSA. BHEL has garnered 65% of the total awards given to Central PublicSector Units.
7. A 500 litres per minute (LPM) capacity Oxygen Generation Plant manufactured by BHEL's Haridwar unit was commissioned on 11th August 2021. This plant has been manufactured with technology from CSIR-IIP Dehradun using Advanced Pressure Vacuum Swing Adsorption technology.



8. BHEL signed an MoU with a Russian company JSC Rosoboronexport, to cooperate and implement possible joint projects and activities related to production of spare parts and components for Russian-origin equipment installed on-board as well as maintenance of systems and equipment of the Indian Navy Aircraft Carrier "Vikramaditya", and on other issues of mutual interest.
9. BHEL received several appreciation letters for its contribution to achieving self-reliance in defence sector:
- (i) Appreciation letter from Defence Research Development Establishment (DRDE) for successful design, development, manufacture, test & supply of 490 kW Alternator for DG set and from Defence Machinery Development Establishment (DMDE) for successful delivery of First Set Permanent Magnet Rotatory frequency converter (PMRFC) AC-AC. This has established BHEL's capability to design and deliver Military grade electrical rotating equipment.
- (ii) Appreciation letter from Cochin Shipyard Ltd for successful maiden sea trials of Integrated Platform Management System (IPMS) of the Indigenous Aircraft Carrier: INS Vikrant.
- (iii) Appreciation letter from Indian Navy for successful resolution of defects of Super Rapid Gun Mounts (SRGM) on-board Indian Naval Ship (INS) Vishakhapatnam.
10. Pursuant to signing of Agreement of Sale between BHEL and Government of Kerala on 28th July 2021, Board of Directors of BHEL Electrical Machines Limited approved the transfer of BHEL's complete 51% share held in BHEL Electrical Machines Limited to Government of Kerala in a meeting held on 11th August 2021.
