#### MONTHLY SUMMARY FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2015

- i. Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the M(HI&PE), GOI and Fraunhofer, Germany: Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Department of Heavy Industry, Ministry of Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises, Government of India and Fraunhofer - Gesellschaft, Germany on cooperation for technology resourcing in the field of Capital Goods was signed on 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 during the visit of the German Chancellor to India from 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2015. Fraunhofer Society (Gesellschaft) is a German applied research organization of global repute.
- ii. MoU between HMT Limited and Fraunhofer: Another MoU was signed between HMT Limited and Fraunhofer on the development of new features in existing products, new product development, analysis of designs for improvement and new technology development.
- iii. Draft National Policy on Capital Goods: A draft 'National Policy on Capital Goods' has been prepared after extensive industry consultations and circulated/uploaded on the DHI Website for comments of other stakeholders/public.
- iv. Scheme for Enhancement of Competiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector: The Second Meeting of the Apex Committee of the Scheme for Enhancement of Competiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary, DHI, on 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2015. The Apex Committee considered and approved the following two proposals (i) Proposal from Indian Institute of Technology, Madras (IIT-M) for development of 11 machine tool technologies under Centre of Excellence component of the Scheme in association with six machine tool companies as Industry partners and (ii) Proposal from HMT Machine Tools under Common Engineering Facility Centre for training and skill development at HMT Training Institute.
- v. 4<sup>th</sup> VDMA Mechanical Engineering Summit held in New Delhi: The 4<sup>th</sup> VDMA Mechanical Engineering Summit was held on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2015 in New Delhi. The VDMA is one of the largest industrial associations in Europe and represents over 3100 member companies in the engineering industry. Secretary, DHI, addressed the Summit on "Manufacturing in India Road to Progress", and explained the slew of measures taken by DHI to promote the capital goods and engineering industries as part of the 'Make in India' initiative.
- vi. Delegation to Vietnam: Joint Secretary (HE&MT) led a composite 19 member delegation comprising officials from Ministry of Commerce, Ministry of Textiles, EXIM Bank and

representatives of industry associations and representatives of textiles/textile machinery sector to Vietnam from 12<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2015. The delegation had been tasked with exploring avenues for utilization of the USD \$300 million Line of Credit offered by Government of India to the Government of Vietnam, with a focus on textile machinery.

- vii. Roundtable on Capital Goods: As a part of continuing outreach to industry, a Roundtable on Capital Goods, Pumps, Valves and Process Equipment at India Chem Gujarat, 2015 was held in Ahmadabad on 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2015.
- viii. Review meeting by Principal Secretary to Prime Minister: A meeting was convened by Principal Secretary to Prime Minister on 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 to review the implementation of decision taken w.r.t. the sick/incipient CPSEs. Principal Secretary was briefed about the present status of the various sick/incipient CPSEs under DHI, and the key issues that needed to be addressed in proposals for closure of CPSEs.
  - ix. Committee of Secretaries (CoS) on disposal of assets of CPSEs under closure: Cabinet Secretariat constituted a Committee of Secretaries (CoS) comprising Secretaries of DHI, Ministry of Corporate Affairs and Department of Disinvestment to re-examine the proposal of DHI with respect of disposal of assets of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) under closure and suggest the best way forward. Accordingly, the CoS deliberated on the issues, and thereafter submitted its report to Cabinet Secretariat on 23<sup>nd</sup> October, 2015.
  - x. Record Order Booking by Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL): BHEL has achieved a total order booking of Rs.22,457 crores upto October 2015 in the current financial year so far, as against Rs. 15,079 crores upto October 2014 during the last financial year.
  - xi. Scooters India Ltd. out of SICA: The Hon'ble Bench of BIFR, New Delhi has noted that the net worth of Scooters India Limited (SIL), Lucknow has become positive by a substantial amount as per Audited Balance Sheets on 31.03.2013 and 31.03.2014, and thus it does not remain a sick industrial company in term of Section 3 (1) (0) of SICA. They have discharged the company from the purview of SICA.
- xii. Violations of emission norms M/s. Volkswagen: In view of the reports of violations of emission norms in the US by M/s. Volkswagen, DHI directed Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI), Pune to conduct road field measurement of the emissions in select Volkswagen diesel vehicles, and the Company was asked to furnish technical data and inputs in this regard. Further action, as warranted, would be taken on the basis of the ARAI findings.
