Monthly Summary of Significant Activities for October, 2017

This has reference to your DO letter No. 502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated August 5, 2014 regarding important issues/developments. The following significant activities have taken place during the month of October, 2017 in the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI).

1. To continue the Government of India's sustained push to electric mobility in India, an Expression of Interest (EoI) has been issued by DM on 31.10.17 under FAME India Scheme for rolling out multi-modal transport based on electric power train. With a grant of up to Rs.105 crore per city from DHI, the rollout seeks to cover a minimum of 5 cities with million plus population. The proposals would be evaluated on the challenge method on the basis of vehicular pollution, number of vehicles registered, performance/ ranking in Swachhata Abhiyan and coverage under the Smart City programme. A special window has also been offered for Special Category states. To augment charging infrastructure for public transport, substantial incentives have been offered to help in overcoming range anxiety, which often comes in the way of electric mobility in public transport. Closing date is 30.11.17, and States have been alerted through D.O. letters from Secretary, HI to Chief Secretaries and from Hon'ble Minister Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises to Chief Ministers.
2. For the upcoming CPSE conclave to be addressed by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Secretary, HI chaired a day-long brainstorming Session for all the senior officials of DHI and Chief Executives of CPSEs under DHI was organized on 6th October, 2017 in India Habitat Centre, New Delhi and a report was sent to D/o Public Enterprises and Cabinet Secretariat.
3. Secretary, HI participated in the 'Make in India Sweden, 2017 Conference' from 12th - 13th October, 2017 organized by D/o Industrial Policy & Promotion to address the roundtables on "Automobile" and "Capital Goods Sector" which had participants from the Industry, Academia and Government from both the Swedish and Indian Side.
4. Secretary, HI chaired a meeting to kick start and develop synergy amongst the projects on Industry 4.0 (SAMARTH UDYOG) funded by DHI This is the first in a series of such planned interactions to bring all the stake holders on a common platform.
5. In a step towards Digital India, BHEL's Retired Employee Pension scheme, a company-wide Pension module has been digitalised right from verification of service details, annuity calculations and Pension application till Pension corpus disbursement.
6. Hon'ble President of India conferred 'Vayoshreshtha Samman' 2017 to BHEL, for the 'Best Public Sector Undertaking in promoting the well-being and welfare of senior citizens'. Hon'ble Vice President of India also presented BHEL with the Humanitarian award by Thakkar Bapa Vidyalaya Samithi, Chennai for renovating the flood ravaged buildings of the institution under Corporate Social Responsibility.
7. BHEL celebrated Utkrishthta Utsav, where 'Excel Awards' were conferred on meritorious employees and Units by Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises.
