Plans for revival of HEC, Ranchi

2666. SHRI MAHESH PODDAR:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a plan to revive Heavy Engineering Corporation (HEC) Ranchi has been formulated;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is any proposal to utilize HEC for production of defence equipments; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a)&(b): A Revival cum Modernization Plan was prepared for HEC by M/s MECON envisaging a comprehensive overhaul of HEC's plants and facilities. The Plan has been further augmented and additional schemes have been included for a more comprehensive overhaul of the Plants and systems of HEC. The total cost of modernization after including contingencies, IDC and pre-operating expenses adds upto Rs. 956.48 crore.

(c) & (d): HEC has informed that it has signed MOU with CINITMASH of Russia for technology for Nuclear and Defence items and with Rosatom, the State Atomic Energy Corporation, Moscow, for components and spares for Nuclear Power Plant to be supplied by Rosatom under joint cooperation.
