**Shifting of industries from Punjab**

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a number of heavy industries/enterprises have shifted from Punjab during the last ten years to other States where they get more incentives given by the Central Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken to compensate the State Government of Punjab in this regard?

(a) to (c): Industry is a State Subject and therefore, no centralized data regarding industries in the country is maintained by the Department of Heavy Industry.
