(a) whether it is a fact that a number of heavy industries/enterprises have shifted from Punjab during the last ten years to other States where they get more incentives given by the Central Government;(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the steps taken to compensate the State Government of Punjab in this regard?

(a)to (c): Industry is a State Subject and therefore, no centralized data regarding industries in the country is maintained by the Department of Heavy Industry. The role of DHI is confined to the administration of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) under its administrative control and the Sector under it.
