**Financial help to tainted consultants by BHEL officials**

40. SHRI SALIM ANSARI:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) have paid huge subscriptions/fees/advertisements to the websites/consulting firms being probed by Crime Branch of Delhi Police in leakage of documents case;
- (b) if so, the details of subscriptions/ fees/advertisements paid to the websites/ portals and consultants so far;
- (c) whether BHEL have also procured documents from these tainted advisers/ consultants; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and action taken against officers of BHEL for extending financial help to tainted consultants/portals etc.?
