- (a) whether there is any scheme for development of heavy industries and public enterprises in the areas like Allahabad where the surrounding areas have abundant mineral deposits;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, whether the Government is contemplating to build major industrial hub in Allahabad having best location benefits and transportation facilities in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?
