Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of the proposal for opening of the Ashok Paper Mill in Jogigopa, Assam; and
- (b) whether the said Paper Mill will start functioning as a production unit in near future?

ANSWER MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

(a)& (b): Hindustan Paper Corporation (HPC) commissioned Techno Economic Study of Ashok Paper Mill, Assam (APM) through renowned consultants, M/s. Sandwell India Consulting Engineers Private Limited, Mumbai and based on the same, a Greenfield Project of 2,00,000 tonnes/annum capacity for manufacture of writing-printing paper with an envisaged investment of Rs. 2476 crore was formulated. In this regard, efforts have been made to obtain various statutory clearances, firm up availability of land, raw materials, finances etc. to expedite reopening of the Mill.
