With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of October, 2023 are highlighted:

- 1. Dr. Mahendra Nath Pandey, Hon'ble Union Minister for Heavy Industries, inaugurated and flagged off 'The Green Plate EV rally' organized by SIAM on 18th October 2023 in partnership with the Ministry of Heavy Industries at Bharat Mandapam, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. Its main objective was to showcase the advancements made by the Indian Automotive industry in the area of electrification and also spread awareness and increase customer confidence among the customers on the excellent quality EV products available in the Indian market.
- 2. On the occasion of 'Rashtriya Ekta Diwas' on 31st October, 2023, Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries, Dr. Mahendra Nath Pandey, administered the National Unity Pledge to all the participants at BHEL HERP, Varanasi and also flagged-off the event 'Run for Unity' as part of celebrations.
- 3. I chaired a meeting with ICEMA (Indian Construction Equipment Machinery Manufacturers' Association) and Industry representatives on 5th October 2023, for industry consultation for understanding the need for Production Linked Incentive scheme for Indian Construction, Earthmoving, Material Handling, and Mining Equipment (CEMM) Manufacturing Industry.
- 4. 'Vigilance Awareness Week' commenced in MHI by administering Integrity Pledge to all officials on 30th October, 2023 be me. I also administered the 'National Unity Pledge' to all officials of MHI on 31st October, 2023.
- 5. Demand Incentive of Rs. 265.00 Cr. (approx.) was released to M/s. IFCI Limited for further disbursement to various original equipment manufacturers (OEMs) in the month of October, 2023 under FAME-India Scheme Phase-II for e-2W, e-3W and e-4Ws.
- 6. Sanction order of 4th & 5th installment (2nd and 3rd tranche) of grant of Rs. 7.2 crore (Rupees Seven Crores Twenty Lakhs only) has been issued to M/s. IFCI Ltd. for further disbursement to Dehradun Smart City Limited (DSCL) for 20 electric buses on Operational Cost Model under FAME India Scheme Phase-II.
- 7. The proposal for enhancement of outlay of "Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Electric Vehicles in India Phase II" from Rs. 10,000 crores to Rs. 11,500 crores have been examined by Department of Expenditure (DoE) and approved considering the objectives of the Scheme.
- 8. Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In October 2023, a total of 360 GST Concession Certificates were issued.

- 9.
