**MISUSE OF RULES BY VEHICLE MANUFACTURERS**

Will the Minister of **HEAVY INDUSTRIES** भारी उद्योग मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that certain electric bike/vehicle manufacturers are misusing rules for low powered vehicles and are supplying higher battery capacity models that ply with top speed of 40-60 kmph without any type approval;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the remedial steps taken by the Government in the matter?

**(a) to (c):** Sir, the Ministry of Heavy Industries has not received complaints regarding misusing rules for low powered vehicles and are supplying higher battery capacity models that ply with top speed of 40-60 kmph without any type approval. Under FAME India Scheme Phase-II, Vehicles, which are registered as “Motor Vehicle” as per the Central Motor Vehicle Rules (CMVR) shall only be eligible for the incentives.
