BATTERY SWAPPING STATIONS

1406. SHRI ADALA PRABHAKARA REDDY:

(a): Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG) has informed that Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) as on 01.07.2022 established 54 battery swapping stations at their Retail Outlets (ROs). The details are given at **ANNEXURE A**.

(b) & (c): For implementing the battery swapping policy, Niti Aayog has uploaded a draft policy on their website for stakeholders consultation.
