**PLI SCHEME FOR HEAVY INDUSTRIES**

**3167. MS. LOCKET CHATTERJEE:**

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES **भारी उद्योग मंत्री** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to shift the power/energy utilisation of the heavy industries to more renewable sources of power/energy and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government is planning to introduce any new Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for this sector under the Make in India initiative; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

**(a):** Sir, on November 11, 2020, the Cabinet had approved the introduction of the PLI Scheme for 10 key sectors, for enhancing India's manufacturing capabilities and exports under Atmanirbhar Bharat initiative. One of the 10 sectors for which the introduction of PLI had been approved by the Cabinet was 'High-Efficiency Solar PV Modules' for achieving manufacturing capacity of Giga Watt (GW) scale in high efficiency solar PV modules.

**(b) & (c):** Sir, no such proposal is under consideration in the Ministry of Heavy Industries.
