- (c) if so, the number of charging stations set up in Kerala; and

**(a):** Sir, the detail of the budgetary allocation and utilization to implement Phase II of FAME–India Scheme is as under:

**(b) to (d):** Yes Sir, Ministry of Heavy Industries has sanctioned 211 charging stations to Kerala state. In addition, this Ministry has also sanctioned 250 e-buses to Kerala state.
