DEVELOPMENT OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES

4285. SHRI HEMANT SRIRAM PATIL:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES आरी उदयोग मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of various schemes launched for the development of heavy industries in the State of Maharashtra during the last three years, district-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to start new schemes in Maharashtra in near future and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the amount of funds sanctioned for Maharashtra for the development of heavy industries in the budgetary allocation for the year 2022-23?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR HEAVY INDUSTRIES (SHRI KRISHAN PAL GURJAR)

- (a): In order to encourage investment in technology upgradation, skill development and augmentation of modern manufacturing capacities in the Capital Goods sector, Ministry of Heavy Industries notified an all-India Scheme for "Enhancement of Competitiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector" (CG Scheme) in the year 2014. The details of projects sanctioned under the scheme in Maharashtra are as follows:
- (i) C4i4 Pune: A common engineering facility center named SAMARTH Udyog centre for Industry 4.0 has been established by Samarth Udyog Technology Forum (SUTF) in Pune district of Maharashtra, in order to demonstrate Industry 4.0 solutions to enable the industries to adopt the same and improve their productivity.
- (ii) Technovuus by ARAI, Pune: (https://technovuus.araiindia.com) TechNovuus is a Technology innovation platform established by Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI) in the Pune district of Maharashtra. It encourages industries to seek solutions for their technological problems from subject experts, scientists, students and researchers at an online platform. Presently it has 11,600 registered users.
- **(b) & (c)**: The Phase 2 of the Scheme for "Enhancement of Competitiveness in the Indian Capital Goods Sector" has been notified on 25th January, 2022 under which proposals can be submitted by Industries, from anywhere in the country. Budget allocation is not done state wise in the scheme.
