- (b) whether ICAT works in collaboration with the private sector; and
- (c) how much income has been generated by the Centre for the services it has provided?

(a) to (c): ICAT has been established as a full-fledged testing and homologation centre within the Northern automotive hub under National Automotive Testing and R&D infrastructure Project (NATRIP). It is one of the authorized testing centres under Central Motor Vehicle Rules (CMVR) and is rendering services like certification/homologation, Design & Engineering, R&D, consultancy and Test & Validation etc. to the automotive sector. It is also providing testing services for LED lamps, UPS systems, electronic appliances, generator sets, medical equipments etc. to non-automotive private sector. The revenue generated by ICAT was Rs. 175.90 crore (net of GST) in FY 2020-21.
