EV CHARGING STATIONS RUNNING ON RENEWABLE ENERGY SOURCES

71 SMT. VANDANA CHAVAN:

Will the Minister of Heavy Industries be pleased to state:

- the number of operational EV charging stations under Phase-II of FAME India Scheme, State and city-wise;
- (b) details of funds allocated and utilized for the same;
- steps taken, if any, to ensure that EV charging stations are powered by renewable energy sources, the timeline to achieve the same and budgetary allocation made and sanctioned;
- the details of public transport vehicles operational under Phase-II of FAME India Scheme, (d) city-wise and amount of funds allocated and utilized under FAME I and II; and
- (e) the corresponding reduction in Greenhouse Gas emissions due to the adoption of aforementioned vehicles since the inception of the FAME scheme?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (E) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 71 FOR 22.07.2022 ASKED BY SMT. VANDANA CHAVAN REGARDING "EV CHARGING STATIONS RUNNING ON RENEWABLE ENERGY SOURCES".

- (a) & (b): Sir, Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG) has informed that Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) as on 01.07.2022 established 3448 electric vehicle charging stations at their Retail Outlets (ROs). Under FAME India Scheme (Phase-I and Phase-II) 532 charging stations have been operationalised as on 15th July 2022 (479 FAME-I and 53 under FAME-II). Details are given at **ANNEXURE A**. Further, the Ministry of Heavy Industries has sanctioned 2877 EV Charging Stations in 68 cities across 25 states/UTs and 1576 charging stations across 9 Expressways and 16 Highways for which about Rs 610 Cr is allocated. Under the Scheme a total of Rs. 1000 Cr. is allocated for the development of charging infrastructure.
- (c): Ministry of Power (MoP) issued revised Consolidated Guidelines & Standards for Charging Infrastructure on 14.01.2022. The guidelines provides that any Public Charging Station/Chain of Charging Stations may obtain electricity from any generation company through open access. Open access shall be provided within 15 days for this purpose. The provision allowing open access would enable the Renewable Energy to be utilized for the purpose of Charging of Electric Vehicles through these Public Charging Stations (PCS).
- (d): Sir, the details of operational vehicles under Phase-II of FAME India Scheme is at **ANNEXURE B**. The fund utilized and allocated under FAME-I and FAME-II is at **ANNEXURE C**.
- (e): Sir, Under FAME India Scheme Phase I and Phase II about 7.67 lakh hybrid and electric vehicles have been incentivsed as on 19th July, 2022 with an estimated savings of 554 million kgs of carbon dioxide emissions.
