**PLI SCHEME FOR ADVANCED CHEMISTRY CELLS**

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount disbursed as incentive under the PLI scheme for the production of Advanced Chemistry Cells;
- (b) how does Government plan to boost research and development in the cell/battery sector;
- (c) whether there are any schemes to promote research and development in the cell/battery industry; and
- (d) whether Government would plan any foreign collaborations for development of different variety of cells, if so, the details thereof?

- (a): The disbursement of incentive will be done from FY 2024-25 for PLI ACC.
- (b) to (d): For boosting R & D in PLI ACC, 5 Gw capacity is earmarked for PLI ACC in Niche (emerging) technology. PLI ACC (Niche) is technology agnostic & higher performance with a minimum threshold capacity of 500 Mwh. Only the higher performance parameters would be pre-requisite for being eligible.
