Respected Sir,

With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated 5th August, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of June, 2024 are highlighted:

- 1. As a part of the 10th International Yoga Day 2024 celebrations, MHI in association with BHEL, organized a Common Yoga Protocol demonstration at BHEL, Noida premises on 21st June, 2024. The Hon'ble Minister (HI & Steel), Shri H.D. Kumaraswamy presided over the event. I alongwith senior officers of my Ministry and BHEL participated in the event.
- 2. MHI has constituted a Joint Task Force (JTF) to prepare 'National Capital Goods Policy, 2025'. This JTF will take up issues of the Capital Goods Industry at a common dialogue platform to evolve a road map and propose strategies and interventions to make India a Manufacturing Hub. Also, for better deliberations, six Working Groups consisting of various Ministries/Departments, Industries and Industrial associations have been constituted to develop pathways for the said policy.
- 3. Under PLI- Auto Scheme, 3 DVA certificates were issued to Mahindra & Mahindra Ltd. and 1 DVA certificate was issued to Sona BLW Precision Forgings Limited by testing agencies of MHI during the month. A workshop was also organized on 26th June, 2024 regarding DVA certification and draft SOP for claims. The workshop had participation from representatives of applicants besides officials from MHI, IFCI and testing agencies of MHI (ARAI, ICAT, GARC & NATRAX).
- 4. Under PLI-ACC Scheme, a meeting was conducted with MNRE on 21st June, 2024 to review progress of 10 GWh Capacity for Grid scale stationary storage. A quarterly progress review workshop / meeting with beneficiary firms, was also held on 25th June, 2024. It was informed by M/s. Ola Cell Tech Pvt. Ltd. that pilot production of approx. 10,000 cells has since been carried out.
- 5. Under Electric Mobility Promotion Scheme (EMPS) 2024, 30 OEMs (110 models) have been registered under e-2w and e-3w segments and claims for incentives of Rs. 2.38 Cr. have been received as of 30th June 2024.
- 6. Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In June 2024, a total of 408 GST Concession Certificates were issued.

- 7. A state-of-the-art pilot demo plant for Electronic Waste treatment was inaugurated at BHEL Tiruchirappalli. The company in collaboration with IIT Madras has developed a zero-discharge process to extract valuable metals like Lead, Tin, and Copper from e-waste. This project aligns with the Swachh Bharat Mission and Atma Nirbhar Bharat campaigns, promoting a circular economy and addressing the growing e-waste challenge in India.
- 8. BHEL contributed in Nalanda University's endeavour towards becoming a net-zero campus. BHEL has designed, supplied, erected & commissioned a 5MW (AC) ground-based solar power plant at the newly inaugurated university campus in Bihar.
