*Respected Sir,*

With reference to D.O. letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2024 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of January, 2025 are highlighted:

1. Hon'ble Vice President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar, visited BHEL's Electronics Division, Bengaluru on 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2025, accompanied by the Hon'ble Governor of Karnataka, Shri Thawar Chand Gehlot and Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries & Steel, Shri H.D. Kumaraswamy. Hon'ble Vice President acknowledged BHEL's efforts in the field of power electronics.
2. The third stakeholders' meeting for the 'Scheme to Promote Manufacturing of Electric Passenger Cars (SMEC)' was held on 16<sup>th</sup> January, 2025, under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister of Heavy Industries, Shri H.D. Kumaraswamy. The OEMs of passenger cars were invited to discuss and provide feedback on the draft guidelines.
3. Hon'ble Union Minister H.D. Kumaraswamy presented the Excel Awards on the eve of BHEL Day on 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2025. Also, the 36<sup>th</sup> issue of BHEL's Hindi magazine 'अरुणिमा' was released.
4. The Bharat Mobility Global Expo 2025 was held from 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2025 at Bharat Mandapam (New Delhi), Yashobhoomi (Dwarka), and India Expo Mart (Greater Noida). The event recorded 9,83,522 visitors, 1500+ exhibitors, 34 OEMs, and 1000+ auto component companies. A total of 239 products were launched, including 90 new vehicles, with participation from 9 countries. Also, 24 conferences covered topics like electrification, road safety, and sustainable mobility, along with thematic pavilions on decarbonization, localization, and recycling.
5. Under PM E Bus Sewa-PSM, Karnataka and Telangana have submitted their Direct Debit Mandate (DDM) to the RBI, following the CESL Expression of Interest (EoI). Feedback from six cities on the draft Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) is under review.
6. Meeting of the Committee on "Re-bidding for 20 GWh ACC capacity" was held on 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2025 to discuss the bid documents provided by MNRE i.r.o. balance 10 GWh ACC capacity earmarked for Grid Scale Stationary Storage application (GSSS). The committee has finalized the bid document and is under approval of competent authority.

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7. BHEL signed MoU with ONGC on 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2025 aiming for collaboration in New & Renewable Energy, including Fuel Cell, Electrolyser, and Battery Energy Storage. Also, on 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2025, BHEL signed 6000 MW  $\pm$ 800kV project contract with POWERGRID, enhancing grid stability and renewable energy integration.
