I would like to bring the following to your notice for the Month of February, 2025:-

- a) The State Governments of Karnataka and Telangana successfully registered the Direct Debit Mandate under the PM e-Bus Sewa Payment Security Mechanism (PSM) Scheme with the Reserve Bank of India.
- b) Programme Agreement was signed on 17th February, 2025 by Reliance New Energy Battery Limited (RNEBL) for 10 GWh (Round-2) under PLI-ACC Scheme. Thus, out of total 50 GWh, 40 GWh has been allocated to PLI beneficiaries so far.
- c) Under PLI-Auto Scheme, two DVA Certificates have been issued to Bajaj Auto Limited by Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI) and one Revalidation Certificates has been issued to Sona BLW Precision Forgings Limited.
- d) Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In February, 2025, a total of 107 GST concession certificates were issued.
- e) The Russian Trade Commission accompanied by a delegation from ROSSETI, PJSC (Russian power utility), led by Director General Mr. Andrey Ryumin visited BHEL on 24th February, 2025 to discuss possible cooperation in the field of HVDC transmission and Steam Turbine Generators.
