Kindly refer to your D.O. letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24th October, 2024. In so far as the Ministry of Heavy Industries is concerned, the report for the month of April, 2025 for your kind perusal is as follows:

- i. Policy and other matters pending due to prolonged inter-ministerial consultations:-NIL.
- ii. Proposals / references pending for long in the Cabinet Secretariat or the Prime Minister's Office:-NIL.
- iii. Particulars of any case in which there has been a departure from Rules of Business:-NIL.
- iv. Any other matter / significant development:-

I would like to bring the following to your notice for the month of April, 2025:-

- a. The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India laid the foundation stone for 800 MW Ultra-Supercritical Thermal Power Plant at Yamunanagar, Haryana on 14th April 2025. Notably, BHEL is an EPC contractor for this project.
- b. The 2nd meeting of Industrial Capital Goods Working Group (ICGWG) was held on 15th April 2025 through virtual mode with participation of Indian and Japanese delegates to take forward the possibilities for cooperation under the umbrella of India-Japan Industrial Competitiveness Partnership (IJICP). The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) and representatives from the textile machinery sector also participated, underscoring a collaborative, multi-sectoral strategy to enhance technological exchange, standardization, and industry partnerships with a view to achieving these shared goals.
- c. The State Government of Punjab and Government of NCT of Delhi have submitted Direct Debit Mandate (DDM) to the Reserve Bank of India under the PM e-Bus Sewa Payment Security Mechanism (PSM) Scheme in April, 2025. DDMs from Karnataka, Telangana, Rajasthan, and Gujarat have been received, covering 5 cities under PM e-DRIVE Scheme: Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Ahmedabad, Surat and Delhi.
- d. Under PLI-Auto Scheme, Domestic Value Addition Certificates were issued to 6 (Six) Champion OEMs for 68 products (variants) & 7 (seven) Component Champions for 23 products (variants). Review meetings were held at MHI on 23rd & 25th April, 2025 to discuss issues concerning claims submission in FY 2025-26 by applicants (who had achieved DVA as on 31.03.2025).

- e. A Technical Committee has been constituted on 15th April 2025 for monitoring and streamlining the implementation of the Omnibus Technical Regulation (OTR) on Machinery and Electrical Equipment Safety, notified on 28th August 2024. 1st meeting of the Committee was convened on 29th April 2025 at Udyog Bhawan, New Delhi with over 52 stakeholders from various Ministries and Industry Associations to discuss the way forward.
- f. Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In April, 2025, a total of 395 GST concession certificates were issued.
- g. North Karanpura in Jharkhand, a prestigious project under execution by BHEL on EPC basis having three supercritical units of 660 MW, has been successfully completed with its 3rd unit commissioned on 14.04.2025. This is a big milestone achieved for improved power availability in the region. The commissioning also resolved the issue being monitored through PRAGATI portal.
