- iii. Identify necessary infrastructure, manpower, and laboratories to support implementation.
- iv. Conduct meetings with industry stakeholders, address queries raised by manufacturers regarding OTR, and provide necessary clarifications.
- v. Deal any other matter related to OTR with the permission of the Chairperson.
