I would like to bring the following to your notice for the month of July, 2025:-

- The Ministry of Heavy Industries organized an event on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2025, presided by the Hon'ble Minister of State (HI) at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi, to commemorate the 125<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee. The event was attended by CMDs/Directors of CPSEs/autonomous bodies, representatives of various industry associations/councils and senior officers of the ministry. The keynote speaker of the event was Shri Binay Kumar Singh, Director, Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee Research Foundation.
- India's first incentive scheme for supporting electric trucks under PM E-DRIVE was notified on 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2025.
- As per DARPG's monthly report for June 2025 titled 'Secretariat Reforms', MHI secured 3<sup>rd</sup> position for 'Revenue Earned from Scrap Disposal' i.e. Rs. 5.71 Crs across Ministries/Departments.
- A Stakeholder Consultation Meeting on "Enhancement of Construction and Infrastructure Equipment (CIE) Manufacturing Ecosystem in India" was held on 09<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 to assess the need and support required for Construction and Infrastructure Equipment (CIE) Industry. The meeting was attended by the representatives from Construction and Infrastructure Equipment Industry, Partner Ministries, Deloitte (Knowledge Partner) and ICEMA members.

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- A meeting was held on 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 to outline the objectives and framework of Automotive Mission Plan (AMP) 2047. The AMP 2047 will be a strategic roadmap with defined targets to boost India's share in global automotive trade through innovation and quality. Seven expert-led sub-committees were formed to guide the plan, setting milestones for 2030, 2037, and 2047.
  - The Phased Manufacturing Programme (PMP) guidelines for EV Public Charging Stations under the PM E-DRIVE scheme was notified on 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2025.
  - Under the PM e-Bus Sewa-Payment Security Mechanism (PSM) Scheme, in July 2025, the State Government of Uttarakhand submitted the Direct Debit Mandate (DDM) to the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). Hence as on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025, total 9 States (Telangana, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Punjab, Meghalaya, Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Uttarakhand) have submitted the DDM to RBI.
  - Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the prominent services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In July 2025, a total of 398 GST concession certificates were issued to the eligible beneficiaries.
  - BHEL associated with the NASA-ISRO SAR (NISAR) Mission launched on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2025. The NISAR satellite is powered by BHEL-manufactured space-grade solar panels and a lithium-ion battery. Also, 112 BHEL-made Li-ion cells were integrated into the Geo-synchronous Satellite Launch Vehicle (GSLV), which successfully deployed the satellite into a Sun-synchronous orbit.
