Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of limited presence of heavy industries and manufacturing clusters in Western Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details of steps taken to promote industrial investment, technology adoption and job creation in the region;
- (c) whether such industrial gaps exist in other parts of the country; and
- (d) if so, the details of the national plan to promote heavy industries and manufacturing growth, State-wise?
