HEAVY INDUSTRIES OF ANCILLARY UNITS

†2923. SHRI NEERAJ MAURYA:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to setup new heavy industries as ancillary units to major industrial establishments such as IFFCO at Aonla, Uttar Pradesh under the Atmanirbhar Bharat scheme;
- (b) whether the lack of heavy industries in the region Enforcing the skilled technical youth to migrate elsewhere and the details of any special industrial package has been announced to address this issue;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up a component cluster for manufacturing of parts of electric vehicle in Aonla;
- (d) the amount of budget allocated so far for the revival of closed machinery units in the region; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Since Industry is a State Subject, as per the Seventh Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) does not maintain any centralized data relating to setting up of new heavy industries in any part of the Country including Aonla, Uttar Pradesh.
