Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of current status of preparation of the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for revival of the glass factory located at Bargarh in Chitrakoot district;
- (b) the details of funds allocated and expenditure made by the Uttar Pradesh State Mineral Development Corporation (UPSMDC) for revival of the said factory;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal and timeline for initiating the tender process for participation of the private sector, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the targeted timeline framed by the Government for making the factory operational again and the number of employment opportunities likely to be generated therefrom; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?
