INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT IN BIHAR

†459. **SHRI GOPAL JEE THAKUR:**

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the initiatives taken by the Ministry during the last five years to promote industrial development and employment generation in Darbhanga Lok Sabha constituency and Mithilanchal region of Bihar;
- (b) whether the Government is proposing any special plan for establishment of industrial units or expansion of manufacturing activities in Darbhanga region;
- (c) the details of industrial projects approved in Bihar under the Atmanirbhar Bharat and Make in India campaign along with the extent of participation of Darbhanga region therein; and
- (d) whether the Government is contemplating on setting up of any industrial cluster or manufacturing unit in Darbhanga Lok Sabha constituency in view of the employment generation for the youth?
