Kindly refer to your D.O. Letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24<sup>th</sup> October, 2024. In so far as the Ministry of Heavy Industries is concerned, the report for the month of August, 2026 for your kind perusal is as follows:

- iv. Any other matter / significant development:-

I would like to bring the following to your notice for the month of August, 2026:-

- “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign was successfully celebrated by the Ministry and its CPSEs/Autonomous Bodies (ABs) from 9<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> August 2026, embodying the spirit of patriotism, national pride and collective participation. The campaign also commemorated 150 years of “Vande Mataram” and its enduring message of national unity and devotion. As part of the campaign, various activities were undertaken, including the hoisting/display of the National Flag, singing of “Vande Mataram”, and uploading of selfies with the Tiranga on the dedicated portal of the Ministry of Culture.
- “Swachhata Pakhwada 2026” was observed successfully by the Ministry and its CPSEs/ABs from 16<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2026. Various activities were organized, including taking swachhata pledge, cleanliness drives, awareness campaigns, Swachhata Quiz, Cleanathons, and community participation. The successful observance of Swachhata Pakhwada reaffirmed MHI’s commitment to the Swachh Bharat Mission and the vision of Viksit Bharat@2047.
- The Ministry organized a three-day workshop on Cyber Security Awareness for officials of the Ministry from 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2026, that focused on strengthening awareness of cyber security practices, promoting responsible digital practices, and reinforcing the safe and secure use of digital resources in official work.

- Under the PLI ACC scheme, the Empowered Group of Secretaries (EGoS), headed by the Cabinet Secretary, approved two-year extension of the timelines for achievement of the prescribed milestones in respect of round-1 (30 GWh) beneficiaries i.e. M/s Ola Cell Technologies Pvt. Ltd. (OCTPL) and M/s Reliance New Energy Battery Storage Ltd. (RNEBSL). The extension is intended to enable the beneficiary firms to complete project implementation and achieve the prescribed Scheme milestones within the revised timelines.
  - Under the PLI-Auto Scheme, aggregate incentive claims of Rs.1,717.24 crore have been disbursed to three approved applicants during the month of August 2026. Till 31.08.2026, the aggregate incentive claims of Rs. 2,505.04 crore have been disbursed to four approved applicants in FY 2026-27.
  - Under the PLI-Auto Scheme, 3 Domestic Value Addition Certificates were issued to 2 applicants (Champion OEMs) during the month of August, 2026. So far, till 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2026, Domestic Value Addition certificates have been issued to 8 Champion OEMs for 129 products (variants) [one DVA certificate is considered void due to Techno-Commercial Audit (TCA) failure] and 10 Component Champions for 47 products (variants) under the Scheme.
  - Under the PM e-Bus Sewa – Payment Security Mechanism (PSM) Scheme, 26 out of 27 participating States/UTs have completed submission of the Direct Debit Mandate (DDM). Further, 736 e-buses under the Scheme have been deployed and are operational across 22 cities.
  - BHEL entered into a strategic tie- up with Hystar AS, Norway which shall enable phased indigenization and local manufacturing of PEM electrolyser systems for green hydrogen projects in India.
  - BHEL was conferred the award for “Highest Procurement by volume by CPSEs in FY 2025–26” during the 10<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day celebrations of Government e-Marketplace (GeM) held on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2026 at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi.
